

Two methods:

A. If you have an old working remote .

- 1. Remove the battery cover of the old remote to reveal the 9 dip switches
- Use a slotted screwdriver to twist/pry open the case of new remote (see the right picture) to reveal the 9 dip switches



3. Set the position (ON/OFF) of each dip switch of the NEW remote exactly the same as those in the old remote.
→ The code setting is complete, press button on new remote to

test.

- B. If you don't have any working remote.
- 1. Randomly set the positions of the 9 dip switches of the NEW remote
- 2. Remove the cover at the lower part of the wall control unit to reveal the "CODE SET" button
- 3. Press "CODE SET" button for one second
- Press the button on the new remote → Programming is done, press new remote to test
