

Garage Remote Programming Instruction - TRG117

If you have an old working remote →

- 1. Remove the battery cover of the old remote to reveal the 8 dip switches
- 2. Use a slotted screwdriver to twist/pry open the case of new remote (see the right picture) to reveal the 8 dip switches
- 3. Set the position (ON/OFF) of each dip switch in the NEW remote the same as those in the old remote*. → The code setting is complete, press button on new remote to test.



If you don't have any working remote ->

- 1. Remove the housing of the drive unit/motor in your garage to reveal the 8 dip switches on the circuit board (Please switch off the power before doing so)
- 2. Set the positions of the dip switches inside the new remote the same as those on the circuit board. → The code setting is complete, press button on new remote to test.
- *: If you old remote only has 7 dip switches, try the #8 dip switch in new remote both ON and OFF to test



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
